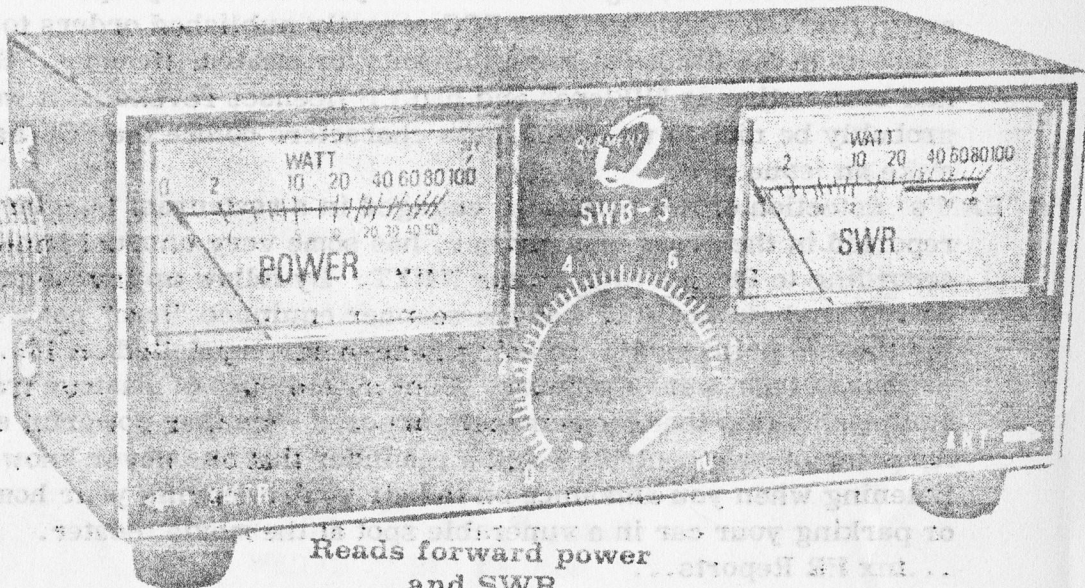

By follow up investigation, Andy found out not only was the scanner equipped "ham" not a ham, but the two policemen were using hand-helds crystallized on 146.52, and neither of them were Amateurs. Non-amateur use of amateur transmitting equipment, this time for criminal purposes - another powerful argument for point-of-sale controls - and a reminder that one never knows who is listening when you announce on the air you're leaving your home empty or parking your car in a vulnerable spot at the movie theater.
