SM engineer invents device

Tom Lott, president of Cromax Technology Inc. on Santa Inez Avenue in San Mateo, has come up with a device that could bring new pleasure to those who are hard of hearing and to mates who have had to suffer with high volume because of the hearing problem.

I dropped by Lott's place the other day to see how he was doing. I have known the San Mateo engineer and inventor for 20 or more years, ever since he was involved with stereo and developments in ham radio. He took the occasion to show me this much-needed device.

Basically it consists of a small stereo radio transmitter about the size of a pocket radio. It has a tiny receiver and a stereo headset that can be adjusted in each ear for both volume and tone.

Some hard-of-hearing persons can hear high tones better than low tones, while others have the opposite problem. This device compensates for either situation.

In addition to its own tiny earphones, the receiver will handle any set of earphones with a 1/8-inch plug. It also allows the user to

hear external sounds such as speech TV.

The transmitter can be plugged VCR or the output of the cablebox.

Lott indicated that several cable offering the equipment for subscribers.

Lott's new invention also will handle church services, lectures and other events through microphones and amplifiers.
