Hi Dick and Happy New Year.

Since I probably won't make it to any of the monthly meetings for an unknown period of time, I thought I might take this opportunity to make a few comments to the group, which you are free to read in my absence to all.

After many years of just contemplating the idea of getting my ham license, it was only about 3 years ago that I had the opportunity to really get serious about it and make the effort to make it happen. When my wife became seriously ill and spent almost 10 months in a hospital intensive care unit, it was the first time in more than 30 years that I found myself very much alone. Often, I would only be able to sleep a few hours at a time. With my new license, it was very helpful to spend some of the early morning hours getting lost in the world of chasing DX. Ham radio has many great advantages and opportunities

a lifelong learning experience.

One weekend afternoon I had the privilege of meeting K6MPN on the air. His friendly demeanor and invitation led me to meet with and join FAARA. From this experience, I discovered such wonderful people as N6FGM and others who eventually led me to SCARES, where I discovered an opportunity to give back something to the world of amateur radio. It has been a wonderful experience to meet and work with such a fine group of people. SCARES is more than just a group of dedicated hams who provide a fantastic service to their communities. It is a group of warm and supportive people who will go out of their way to help anyone in need. I cannot tell you how much it has meant to me to be part of such a fine group without making this message a novel.

In as short a message as I can give you, however, let me say that I am proud to have been a part of SCARES and to have been able to know so many of you. If amateur radio is to survive, it will only happen because of the dedication of groups such as SCARES. And, if the human race is to survive, it will only happen because of the warmth of people such as yourselves who give to others with only the personal satisfaction of giving as a reward.

Events of 1998 have been both happy and sad. I am leaving for a new job. Opportunity in southern California, in the hopes of beginning a new life for myself and my children. Intellectually, I know it is the right thing to do, but emotionally I am leaving a lot of happy memories behind, and that is very difficult. But, I could not leave without saying to all of you that I thank you for allowing me to be a part of the SCARES organization. Keep up the super work that you are doing. I will miss all of you, but hope to some day visit once again. My special thanks to K6ANN, AA6WT, WD6DGT, and N6XMO for all the support you have given me during some difficult times, and to K6MPN and N6FGM for both support and for leading me to such a bunch of such special folks. VE EXAM WARM UP WORKSHOP

Some PAARA members will be offering a pre-test workshop to prepare test takers for the VE test experience. If you know anyone who is planning to take their first ham test or if you are planning to upgrade, this class will help. Practice code and written tests will be given. These will be practice tests only and NOT the actual tests that will be given at the VE session.

The workshop is for the purpose of acquainting applicants with procedure and format in a simulated test environment, and will not be concerned with actual exam contents. 610 forms will be available for those who wish to complete them prior to the test session.

The workshop will be held on Wed., March 13, at 7:30 pm at the Menlo Park fire station at 300 Middlefield Rd., Menlo Park. There is no charge for the class.

The PAARA sponsored VE team administered 74 elements, novice through extra, to 37 people during their February session at Ampex. 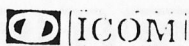

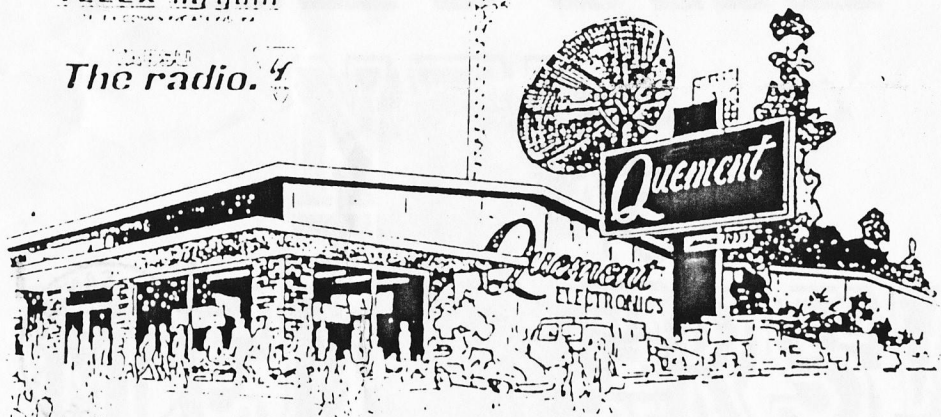

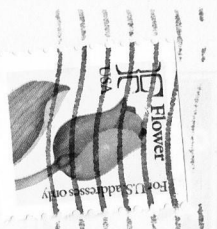
